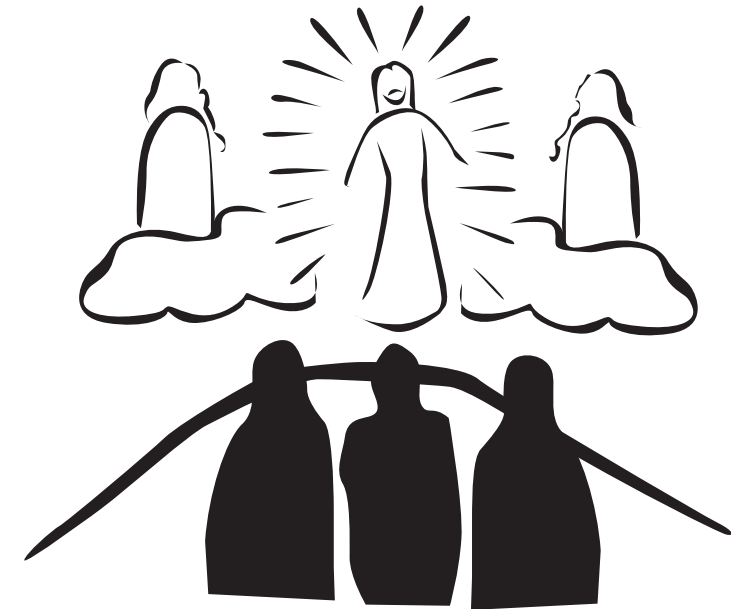
UMW Mission Fund Raiser An Afternoon at the Theatre Sunday, March 7, 2:30 p.m.
